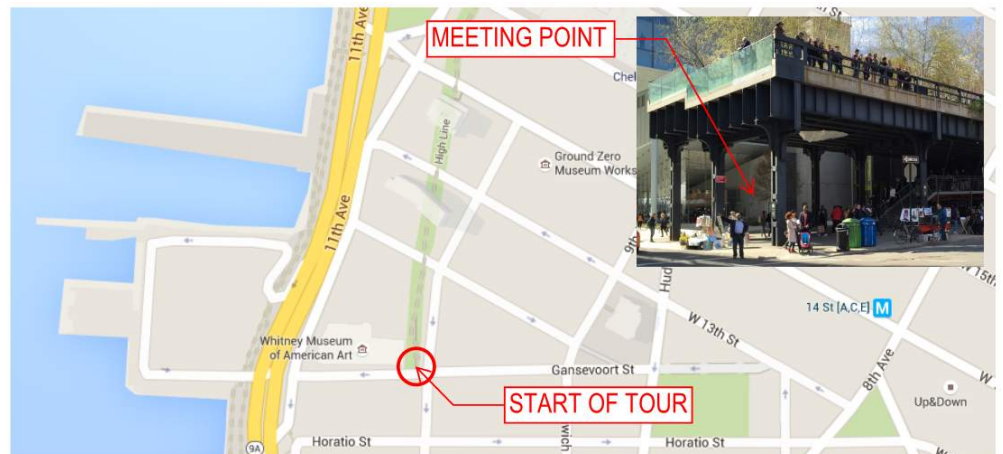
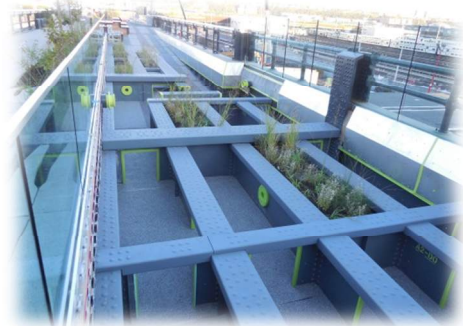
The ICE invites you to a High Line Engineering Tour
